**ORDER ADOPTING MAGISTRATE JUDGE'S
REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION**

Pursuant to Local Civil Rule 72.3, the Court referred this case to Magistrate Judge John M. Facciola for a report and recommendation on Counterclaimants' Motion for Award of Attorneys' Fees and Costs [Dkt. #52]. Magistrate Judge Facciola issued a Report and Recommendation on February 23, 2009.

Under Local Civil Rule 72.3(b), parties may file objections within ten days of service of a magistrate judge's report. A party's failure to file an objection within that ten days may waive appellate review of a District Court order adopting the report and recommendation. *See* LCvR 72.3(b). Pursuant to the final extension of time granted by the Court, the parties' objections were due on or before April 10, 2009.
