Pursuant to the “2010 Revision to the 2001 Plan for Compliance and Conclusion of *Evans v. Fenty*,”¹ (“2010 Plan”), the Special Master, Clarence J. Sundram, has submitted four report and recommendations regarding defendants’ compliance with three of the nine areas specified therein: staff training, safeguarding personal possessions, and adequate budget. *See* Special Master’s Report and Recommendation Regarding Staff Training-Part I, July 6, 2012 [ECF No. 1318]; Special Master’s Report and Recommendation Regarding Safeguarding Personal Possessions, Sept. 26, 2012 [ECF No. 1336]; Special Master’s Report and Recommendation Regarding Staff Training-Part II, Sept. 28, 2012 [ECF No. 1338]; Special Master’s Report and Recommendation Regarding Adequate Budget, Oct. 5, 2012 [ECF No.
