## ORDER

For the reasons stated in the accompanying Memorandum Opinion, it is by the Court hereby

ORDERED that defendants' motion for summary judgment is GRANTED in part and DENIED in part; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that all of plaintiffs' claims EXCEPT (1) More's age discrimination claim for the 1998-130-YDC promotions, and (2) the age discrimination claims of Guion, More, Hughes, Haynesworth, Watson, and Williams for the 2001-002-GCM promotions, are DISMISSED with prejudice; and it is FURTHER ORDERED that plaintiffs' motion for sanctions is DENIED, the denial being without prejudice with regard to the missing KSA files, and with prejudice with regard to Commander Ashton's notes; and it is

**FURTHER ORDERED** that the parties shall jointly submit a recommendation for future proceedings in this case by no later than April 20, 2007.
