PHARMACIST STATEMENT

1. My name is LEONARD KRICK, RPh. I currently reside at 2110 Princeton Ave., Camp Hill, Pa.. I have been a practicing pharmacist since having graduated from Philadelphia School of Pharmacy in 1954.
2. I am/was a pharmacist at REA and DERRICK PHARMACY (hereafter referred to as the Pharmacy), located at WEST SHORE PLAZA during the period of 1960 to 1978. LEMOYNE, PA.
3. In the 1960's, the Pharmacy dispensed approximately 300 prescriptions a day to the general community.
4. In the 1960's, I conducted the practice of pharmacy, which included ordering, stocking, and dispensing prescription drugs. I generally worked from 8:00 AM to 5:30 PM, 6 days a week.
5. In the 1960's, the Pharmacy purchased pharmaceuticals from the following wholesalers:
Hensel & Sons - Harrisburg, Pa.
Drug House - Harrisburg, Pa.
6. I recall the BORTELL family as customers, although I cannot recall any particular prescription.
7. During 1960, the Pharmacy stocked Lilly brand of diethylstilbestrol (DES).
8. Based upon my recollection of the usual and ordinary routine in the 1960's, if a prescription for DES was brought into the Pharmacy, the Lilly brand would have been dispensed.
9. I have in my mind's eye an actual recollection of a bottle of Lilly brand of DES on my shelves and no recollection of any other brand of DES besides Lilly brand.

I state under penalty of perjury that the attached statement dated 5/21/04 regarding the exclusive use of the Lilly brand DES product at Rea & Derrick Pharmacy is true and correct.
