REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION ON MODIFICATION OF SUPERVISED RELEASE

At a hearing held on March 2, 2010, all parties consented to the modification of Defendant's conditions of supervised release and there being no objection thereto, accordingly on this 2nd day of March, 2010, IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT the Defendant's conditions of supervised release be modified to include: The Defendant shall participate and complete no more than 180 days in the Residential Reentry Center placement as directed by the United States Probation Office; cost to be waived. In addition, the Defendant will be released to the 3rd party Custody of the United States Probation Office upon designation to the Residential Reentry Center.
