



doctrine of res judicata applies. Brown v. Califano, 75 F.R.D. 497, 498 (D.D.C. 1977). Further, compliance with Rule 8(a)'s requirements should provide a court with sufficient information to determine whether it has jurisdiction over the claims.

Here, the handwritten complaint states in its entirety as follows: "Building on 14 St. Security advanced on me to after told store was closed. Forcing me to defend self peddling knife force away put in [indecipherable] evid 1 day 6 along with this DC General Hospital Security stealing tobacco 2 bag and 10 dollars due to harm way forced upon 100000000 in refurbishment. Ain't got much time Justice Prevail quickly." This complaint does not meet the minimum requirements of Rule 8. Accordingly, the complaint will be dismissed without prejudice to refile. A related Order accompanies this Memorandum Opinion.
