Defendants filed a motion to dismiss on August 17, 2010. In its August 23, 2010 Order, the Court advised plaintiff, among other things, of his obligation to file an opposition or other response to the motion. Further, that Order expressly warned plaintiff that, if he failed to file his opposition by September 24, 2010, the Court would treat the motion as conceded.
