

ORDER

In a hearing before Magistrate Judge John M. Facciola on December 13, 2010, defendant Elemer A. Ramirez-Lepe entered a plea of guilty. On that date, the magistrate judge issued a Report and Recommendation advising the Court to accept defendant's plea. The Court has received no objection to the Report and Recommendation. *See* Local Crim. R. 59.2(b) ("Any party may file for consideration by the district judge written objections to the magistrate judge's proposed findings and recommendations . . . within fourteen (14) days after being served with a copy thereof.").
