MEMORANDUM OPINION

Pursuant to the schedule set forth in the Court's September 29, 2011 Order [Dkt. #6], the defendant filed a motion for judgment of affirmance [Dkt. #8] on November 21, 2011. In its December 2, 2011 Order, the Court advised the plaintiff, among other things, of his obligation to file an opposition or other response to the motion.
