## MEMORANDUM OPINION

By Order entered on June 29, 2012, within 30 days plaintiff was ordered to submit a certified copy of his trust fund account statement (or institutional equivalent), including the supporting ledger sheets, for the six-month period immediately preceding the filing of this pleading, obtained from the appropriate official of each prison at which plaintiff is or was confined.<sup>2</sup> 28 U.S.C. § 1915. The deadline has passed. Although plaintiff has submitted an additional document titled "Amended Complaint; Motion for Appointed Counsel; Motion to Compel United States Officers Perform Duty Owed; Damages and Jury Trial Demanded," to date, he neither has submitted the required financial information nor has paid the \$350.00 filing fee. Accordingly, the Court will deny his application to proceed *in forma pauperis* and will dismiss the complaint without prejudice.
